**8. Draw**

The Draw will be made, under the supervision of ATTU Technical Committee.

Draw for team events will take place on 22<sup>nd</sup> July at 18:00hrs.

Draw for individual events will take place on 23<sup>rd</sup> July. Exact time for the draw will be advised by the organizer.

**9. Jury**

The Jury will meet on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2007 at 16:00hrs , and on subsequent occasions during the Championships if required. An Association directly affected by a matter under consideration is entitled to be represented at the meeting.

**10. Entry**

- (1) A qualified Association may nominate a) not more than 4 junior players for the Boy's team events; not more than 4 players for the Girls team events; b) 4 players for Boy's Singles and 4 players for Girls Singles; c) 2 pairs for Boys and Girls Doubles.

- (2) An Association which has not qualified may enter a maximum of 2 players in singles event and one pair in the doubles event and with their own expenses.
- (3) Each Association is allowed to send not more than 3 Cadet Boys and 3 Cadet Girl's players to take part in Cadet Teams & Individual Events.
- (4) The Host Association can enter 6 male and 6 female junior players; 6 male and 6 female cadet players.

## 11. System of Play

### ➤ Junior Boys and Junior Girls Events

The Competition shall be conducted in two stages.

**1<sup>st</sup> Stage-** All the teams except the winner and runner-up teams of previous Asian Junior Championships shall be divided in two groups and play in the single round robin system.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Stage-** The first three teams from both groups and the winner and runner-up teams of previous Asian Junior Championships shall play by progressive knockout system to determine one to eight positions except for third and fourth positions. Remaining three teams from each group shall also play by progressive knockout system to determine nine to fourteen positions.

Order of play: A v/s X, B v/s Y, C v/s Z, A v/s Y, B v/s X.

All matches shall be played in best of five (5) games.

### **Individual events:**

All the single events shall be played in two stages. In the first stage, all the players will be divided into groups with 3 or 4 players in each group. They shall play one another in Round Robin League System to determine the order of positions in each group. In second stage, players in the first placing from different groups shall play against each other according to knock out system. The matches in 1<sup>st</sup> stage will be played to the best of five (5) games. All the matches in 2<sup>nd</sup> stage shall be played to the best of seven (7) games.

Doubles events will be played on knock out system on best of five (5) games.

### ➤ Cadet Events

#### **Team Event**

The Competition will be played in two stages, 1<sup>st</sup> stage in Group League and 2<sup>nd</sup> stage in Knock-out system on Corbillon Cup Format. The Team to be composed of 2 to 3 players A v/s X, B v/s Y, Doubles, A v/s Y, B v/s X.

### **Singles Event**

Singles will be played in two stages, 1<sup>st</sup> stage in Round Robin System in Group of 3 players by best of 5 games.

2<sup>nd</sup> stage will be played by Knock-Out system by best of 5 games up to best 16.

Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals will be played by best of 7 games.

## **12. Hospitality**

The Organizing Committee will provide free hospitality from the Dinner on 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2007 to the Breakfast of 27<sup>th</sup> July 2007 which includes the board and lodging to the following:

- a. Not more than 4 players including playing and non-playing captain competing in both the Junior Boys and Junior Girls Team Event.
- b. Not more than 2 players including playing and non-playing captain competing only in the Cadet Boy's Team Event
- c. Not more than 2 players including playing and non-playing captain competing only in the Cadet Girl's Team Even
- d. Not more than 2 players if competing in Boys **and** Girls Individual Events.
- e. Not more than 1 player if competing in Boys or Girls Individual Events.
- f. Not more than 2 players if competing in Cadet Boys **and** Girls competition.
- g. Not more than 1 player if competing in Cadet Boys or Girls Competition.
- h. One official accompanying the teams.
- i. All member of ATTU Executive Board, ATTU Honorary Officials, full member of the Technical and Rules Committee, Coaching and Junior Committee and the invited ATTU Secretariat Staff.
- j. International Umpires and Referees from other Association invited in accordance with advice of ATTU.
- k. The expenses of the Chairman of the Technical & Rules Committee/Technical delegate including Air Passage to the Championships (1 person).

## **13 Accompanying visitors**

Players and Officials who are listed on Associations official entry forms but who are not entitled to free hospitality can be accommodated with the other and on the same basis, including meals, Transport and Admission, at a charge of EURO100 per person per day in a twin/ Double Room or EURO150 per person per day in a Single Room. All players and officials will be accommodated in the four Star Hotel. The address and other details will be sent to you separately .The same rates apply for days not covered by free hospitality.

**14 Awards**

In both Team and Individual Events, the winner, runner-ups and 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-ups will receive gold, silver and bronze medals respectively.

- a. Four medals per team will be awarded to the winners of the Junior Team events.
- b. Two medals per team will be awarded to the winners of the Cadet Team events.
