■ Overall mission/vision

“To provide participating National Association with, individually based excellence oriented planning and management support for identified athletes, in order to create the best possible opportunities to quickly advance on the ITTF World Ranking list. Each of the athletes will be subject to individual planning - management input and evaluation/ follow up”

■ Objectives:

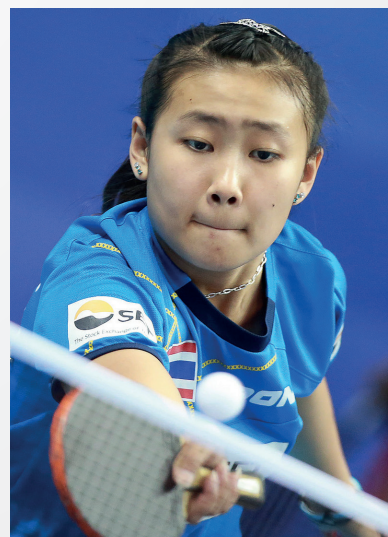
Individual scholarship programme built to support emerging associations outside the established elite group of top five associations in Asia. By providing coaching education - planning input and excellence driven initiatives participating national associations and the targeted athletes should be offered high quality training and competition alternatives boosting the opportunities to advance on the ITTF World Ranking list as the nr one point of reference.

Project Overview – Flow of activities



■ Advanced Excellence Scholarship – Definition

- Funding provided by the ATTU – Active and improved management will be provided.
- Project is open for nominations from National Associations within the Asian TT Family
- Priority is given to emerging national associations outside the established top six countries (China, Chinese Taipei, Japan, Hong Kong, Singapore, Korea Republic)
- Potential athletes are targeted based on fast-track opportunities defined as predicted quick progress on the ITTF World Ranking List.
- Selected athletes should be accompanied by a National Association nominated coach at all times for supported events: training and competition.
- The scholarship will NOT cover airfare to and from designated activities/events
- All entries into competition are the sole responsibility of the National associations.





■ Supported Events: Training Options

- The project will use – depending on the skill-level of the athlete top class training environment.
- Priorities are to build activities based on the principles of **PROPER PREPARATION – QUALITY EVENTS – PROFESSIONAL EVALUATION**
- Supported events will be identified early in the process and the project management will work directly with the organizers in terms of practical arrangements.
- Clear and open line of communication will be applied by the project management.

■ Timeframe

- Phase ONE: Nomination / identification of athletes and National associations agreement 2014
- Phase TWO: Planning and implementation of designated activities January - August 2015
- Phase THREE: Evaluation, nomination and selection for RIO 2016

■ Number of athletes

Maximum Two boys + two girls for Phase ONE - Up to maximum four and four to be added for phase THREE - Rio 2016. Final selections to be approved by the ATTU Executive board.

■ Planning 2015

At least one or possibly two key junior events might be added depending on the composition of the athletes group 2015. World Tour events to be determined.

■ Detailed planning and budget

Coaches cost/accommodation – Athletes cost/accommodation will be covered by the scholarship. Special training initiatives can be added prior to each event and included in the scholarship agreement/contract.

Individual scholarship per athlete and year: USD 7.000

Estimated budget 2015 activities: 30-32.000 USD
