## Prospectus(V1.3)

### 1. Authority

The 20th Asian Table Tennis Championships will be organized by the Macau Table Tennis Association under the authorization of Asian Table Tennis Union.

### 2. Date and Place

The Championships will be held at Macau S.A.R. China from 23rd February to 1st March 2012.

Venue : Macau East Asian Games Dome, Cotai, Macau S.A.R.

### 3. Events

The following events will be played

- Event 1: Men's Team
- Event 2: Women's Team
- Event 3: Men's Singles
- Event 4: Women's Singles
- Event 5: Men's Doubles
- Event 6: Women's Doubles
- Event 7: Mixed Doubles

The Draw will be made under the supervision of ATTU Technical Committee. Draw for Team Events will take place on 21st February at 18:00 and for Individual Events on 23<sup>rd</sup> February at 15:00.

## **7. Jury**

The Jury will meet on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2012 at 17:00 and on subsequent occasions during the Championships if needed. The jury shall include referee, all coach representatives and team captain. An Association directly affected by a matter under consideration is entitled to be represented.

## **8. System of Play**

### **Team Event**

Team Events will be divided into 1<sup>st</sup> Division and Champion Division.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Division

According to the entries, all teams excluding top 6 teams (produced from last Asian Championships) will be divided into 2 or 4 groups. In the first stage, all groups play in round robin system to produce group winners and group losers. In the second stage, group's winners play in knock-out system to produce top 2 teams that directly enter the Champion Division. According to their results in Champion Division, the team with higher ranking will be the Champion of 1st Division, and the other team with lower ranking will be runner-up of 1st Division. Group losers play in knock-out system to decide their final positions.

#### Champion division

Champion Division starts directly from 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage and plays knock-out system.

Champion Division consists of top 6 teams produced from last Asian Championships and top 2 teams produced from the 1<sup>st</sup> Division.

Matches order in team events are A vs X, B vs Y, C vs Z, A vs Y, B vs X. All matches will be played by best of 5 games.

## **Individual Events**

All individual events shall be played in knock-out system. Matches in singles event shall be played in best of seven games and all doubles matches shall be played in best of five games up to quarter finals. The Semi finals and Finals shall be played by best of seven games.

## **Seeding & Draw**

### **Team Events**

Seeding of the teams for both Champion Division and 1<sup>st</sup> Division shall be based on the results of the last Asian Championships.

For the positions of 8 teams in Champion Division, Team Champion and Team Runner-up will go to position 1 at the top position 8 at the bottom.

Team No.3 and Team No.4 will be drawn to position 4 and position 5.

Team No.5 , Team No.6, and the top 2 teams produced from 1<sup>st</sup> Division will be drawn between position 2, position 3, position 6 and position 7.

For association that did not participate in the last Asian Championships and associations that participate in this Asian Championships for the first time, their team's ranking and individual players' ranking will be based on ITTF Team Ranking and ITTF individual Ranking . The Technical & Rules Committee is entitled to have the final decision.

## **Individual Events**

For Individual Events the latest World ranking of ITTF will be taken as the base for the seeding purpose.

## **9. Hospitality**

The Organizing Committee shall provide free hospitality from the dinner of 22nd February 2012 to the breakfast of 2nd March 2012 which includes board and lodging to the following:

- (9.1) not more than 8 players including playing and non-playing captain competing in both the men's and women's event.
- (9.2) not more than 4 players including playing and non-playing captain competing only in men's team event.
- (9.3) not more than 4 players including playing and non-playing captain competing only in women's team event.
- (9.4) one (1) delegate from each of the Association if he is not included in the nominated players listed above.

- (9.5) The Chairman of the Technical Committee and ATTU Secretariat staff shall be given hospitality 3 days prior to the commencement of the Championships.
- (9.6) Same hospitality shall be provided to associate members, extra persons or for the extra period of stay at the expense of US\$180 for Single room per person and US\$150 for Double Room per person per day.
- (9.7) Those participating players, coaches and officials who will not use official accommodation should pay US\$250 per person as the entry fee.
- (9.8) All members of ATTU Executive Board, ATTU Honorary officials, Chairmen of all committees, full members of the Technical and Rules Committee shall be given free hospitality from the day before the event starts to the day after the event ends.

### **10. Entry**

Entries shall be submitted only in the entry form attached to this prospectus

- (10.1) An Association may nominate not more than 5 players for the men's team event, and no less than 3 players; not more than 5 players for the women's team event and no less than 3 players; 5 players for men's singles; 5 players for women's singles; 2 pairs for men's and women's doubles and 2 pairs for mixed doubles.
- (10.2) All players taking part in the men's and women's singles may participate in the men's and women's doubles and mixed doubles. Pairing of players from different associations is not permissible.
- (10.3) Preliminary entry should be submitted before 10th Dec. , 2011.**
- (10.4) The last date for submission of Final entries 13<sup>th</sup> Jan. 2012**
- (10.5) Closing Date for Travel Plan : 1st Feb. 2012**
- (10.6) Canceling entry and accommodation: For those association who cancel their entry and accommodation after 10<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2012, the organizing committee will charge US \$**

**90 per person per day.**

#### **11. Accompanying Persons**

Officials who are listed on Associations official entry forms but not entitled to free hospitality can be accommodated with the other on the same basis, including meals, Transport and Admission, at a charge of US\$150 per person per day in a Twin / Doubles Room or US\$180 per person per day in a Single Room. All fee paying officials will be accommodated in the four / three star hotel.

#### **12. Awards**

In both Team (Champions Division) and Individual Events, the winner, runner up and Loosing Semi Finalists will receive gold, silver and bronze medals respectively. The winner and runner up of the 1st Division team championship will also receive Gold and Silver medals respectively.

Racket Testing will be conducted in this competition and the test will be conducted under ITTF Regulations.

Anti-Doping Control shall be carried out at championships in accordance with ITTF and IOC Rules.
