<b>1A AUTHORITY</b>	The Qualification Event for the Games of the XXXII Olympiad in Tokyo in 2020 will be organized by the <b>Table Tennis Association of Thailand (TTAT)</b> , under the authority granted by the <b>International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF)</b> and the <b>Asian Table Tennis Union (ATTU)</b> .

<b>5 ELIGIBILITY</b>	All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to, Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors). Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate at the Asian Qualification Tournament.  The ITTF international eligibility regulation 4.5.1 shall apply.
<b>6A RULES</b>	The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis, the Regulations for International Competitions.

**6B PROCEDURES OF SELECTION**

- 6.1 With allocation from ITTF, six (6) men and six (6) women will be selected from Asia by the qualification tournament in Asia to participate in the Games of the XXXII Olympiad in 2020.
- 6.2 One (1) player from each regional zone (Central Asia, East Asia, South Asia, South East Asia and West Asia) will be selected from the respective regional zone.
- 6.3 Apart from the West Asia Region, that would organise a regional qualification event for players of the West Asia region, players from other regions will compete among themselves in this tournament to determine a total of four (4) regional quota places per gender, with one from each region apart from the West Asia region.
- 6.4 The remaining one (1) Asian Continental quota place shall be allocated to the highest ranked player among the respective first reserve players in each regional qualification, based on the May 2020 Individual Olympic Ranking Lists.
- 6.5 One Mixed Doubles pair will be selected from Asia by the qualification tournament in Asia.

**7 SYSTEM OF PLAY****Singles Events:**

- 7.1 Depending on the exact number of entries in each regional zone, the system of play will either be a single stage round-robin system or a two-stage round-robin group and knock-out system. The draw shall be conducted according to the ITTF Regulations for International Competition based on the ITTF World Ranking at the time of the draw.
- 7.2 If the number of entries in a region is **less than 6**, a single stage round-robin system will be played. Winner of the round-robin system shall qualify for the Games of the XXXII Olympiad in 2020 and the runner-up shall be the reserved player.
- 7.3 If the number of entries in a region is **between 6 and 8**, the competition shall be in 2 stages. The first stage shall consist of **2 groups of 3 or 4 players** in a round robin system, with the top two players going to a second stage knock-out system. Winner of the knock-out system shall qualify for the Games of the XXXII Olympiad in 2020 and the runner-up shall be the reserved player.
- 7.4 If the number of entries in a region is **between 9 and 11**, the competition shall be in 2 stages. The first stage shall consist of **3 groups of 3 or 4 players** in a round robin system, with the top two players going to a second stage knock-out system. Winner of the knock-out system shall qualify for the Games of the XXXII Olympiad in 2020 and the runner-up shall be the reserved player.
- 7.5 If the number of entries in a region is **between 12 and 16**, the competition shall be in 2 stages. The first stage shall consist of **4 groups of 3 or 4 players** in a round robin system, with the top two players going to a second stage knock-out system. Winner of the knock-out system shall qualify for the Games of the XXXII Olympiad in 2020 and the runner-up shall be the reserved player.
- 7.6 If the number of entries in a region is **more than 16**, the competition shall be in 2 stages. The first stage shall consist of **5 or 6 groups of 3 or 4 players** in a round robin system, with the top two players going to a second stage knock-out system. Winner of the knock-out system shall qualify for the Games of the XXXII Olympiad in 2020 and the runner-up shall be the reserved player.
- 7.7 If subsequent reserves are needed, he/she will be determined from the May 2020 Individual Olympic Ranking Lists from those players who competed in the event.
- 7.8 Players of the same NOC shall be separated in different groups during Stage 1 (if applicable) and in different halves (if possible) in the knock-out stage.
- 7.9 All matches shall be played best of seven (7) games.

**Mixed Doubles Event:**

The Mixed Doubles shall be played in a knock-out system and shall be played in best of seven (7) games. Winner of the knock-out system shall qualify for the Games of the XXXII Olympiad in 2020 and the runner-up shall be the reserved pair.

Seedings for all events will be based on the latest available Individual and Mixed Doubles Olympic Ranking Lists on 3 April 2020 09:00 hr. local time.

Each NOC that has not already qualified for the Men's Team Event may enter a maximum of 2 players for the Men's Singles event.

Each NOC that has not already qualified for the Women's Team Event may enter a maximum of 2 players for the Women's Singles event.

Each NOC that has not already qualified a Mixed Doubles pair may enter 1 pair for the Mixed Doubles event.

Entries should be submitted before the deadlines as follows:

- Online Entry will start from **6th February 2020**

- Final entries by **6th March 2020**;

- Accommodation and travel details by **30th March 2020**.

In addition, each Association needs to send the accreditation photos (jpg file) for their members who will participate in the event to the organizing committee for the preparation of the accreditation.

No additional entry is allowed after the final entry, except changes due to injuries of players, received by OC, ATTU Secretariat and ITTF CM before **30th March 2020** at 12:00 hr. local time.

**14 LIABILITY**

By entering the tournament, participants agree to abide by all ITTF and ATTU rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All entered associations, pairs and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the ATTU and ITTF and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition.

Any participant, when called upon, must appear promptly to press conferences or medal presentations and follow the procedures set by the ATTU and the Organizing Committee.

By entering the tournament, each Association must ensure that all delegation members confirm that they know that their personal data will be shared with the Organizers, ATTU and ITTF who, in turn, undertake not to share it with any unauthorized person in any way.

By entering the tournament, all delegation members undertake to abide by the ITTF's anti-doping rules and Anti-Harassment Policy and Procedure.

**15 INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS**

In the context of betting, participants shall not, by any manner whatsoever, infringe the principle of fair play, show unsporting conduct, or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition, or any part thereof, in a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of ITTF regulation 3.5.3.

<b>16</b>	<b>VISA</b>	For those who would need a visa to enter into Thailand, please contact the organizers to get a letter of invitation at least 1 month in advance, with: Full name, nationality, passport number with expiration date, address and occupation and also birthday and place of birth.
<b>17</b>	<b>RACKET CONTROL</b>	If racket control includes official test for VOC miniRAE device will be used according to the ITTF decision. In this case, players will be offered the possibility of voluntary tests before competition starts. The ITTF Equipment Committee strongly recommends to all players to make certain that new racket coverings (rubbers) are aired 72 hours before use.
<b>18</b>	<b>INSURANCE</b>	By entering the tournament, each Association must ensure that all delegation members have medical, travel and other appropriate insurance for the duration of the tournament.
